Once you have downloaded the APP you will need to search for our school. Our new APP is linked directly to our website so all newsletters, school news, dates and information is linked. We would like to say a big thank you again to the Friends of the School and the Parish Council for funding our new website and APP. We hope you enjoy perusing the website and welcome any feedback on additional information or pages that you feel would be beneficial.

Open Morning

Our annual Open Morning will be on Wednesday 24th October. This is a great opportunity for parents/carers/grandparents to come and see the children learning in the school environment; to see their work on display and the books they are currently working in. This year the morning will run as follows:

- From 9.00am come through the main entrance into the hall.
- From 9.10-10.40am an opportunity to visit classes throughout school during their lessons, view teaching and learning and speak to the staff in school. Children will be participating in more active lessons which lend themselves to a bit more disruption!
- 10.40am -refreshments will be served in the hall and several members of our Governing Body will be available to talk to you.
- 11.00-11.30am School Council, Sports Crew, Junior Travel Ambassadors (JTAs) and Health and Safety Ambassadors will be available to talk to in the hall to share with you the work and projects they have led or are planning to do this year.

The school will be open from 9-11.30am with the option of coming for part of the morning or staying for the whole event. We look forward to seeing you then.

Lunchtime Arrangements

We have increased in size this year from 169 to 184 children and therefore we have had to review our lunchtime routine, in order to ensure all of the children have enough time to eat their meals within the lunch hour. We are aware that some children have felt quite rushed at lunch to eat their meals and we have been looking at ways forward to ensure all of the children have ample time. We have extended our Midday Supervisor's hours so that the children have longer to eat their meals. We have also started serving the Reception children from 11.50am closely followed by Year 1. We hope that these changes will improve the situation and we will continue to monitor lunchtime arrangements. Many thanks for your cooperation and understanding.

Fun Run

Harvest

Our Harvest Celebration Assembly will be held in school with the children and Revd Elliott on Tuesday 9th October. For our Harvest collection this year we are kindly asking for donations to be sent into school for the Driffield Food Bank. There has already been a separate letter sent home with more information about suitable items to donate. Many thanks in advance of your support. We hope that together we can support others and make a significant difference.

First Savers Bank

We operate a First Savers Bank in school every Tuesday and one of our school governor's, Mrs Audrey Bjorndal, gives up her time to make this happen. It is open in the Year 6 classroom through the ICT Suite from 8.30-9am and is a great way to encourage children to save and learn about money.

Children can pay in as much or as little as they like and certificates are given when a child reaches certain milestones in their savings. Any child opening a new account is given a free 'piggy' money box to help them save, and throughout the year there are competitions where prizes can be won.

We would love to open more accounts for children, or even siblings that do not attend the school. If you have any queries, call in on a Tuesday morning for a chat.

Junior Travel Ambassadors (JTAs)

Our new JTAs have been appointed and they have had their first meeting with Christian Jordon (our Road Safety Officer). There are several events planned that the children can take part in and Christian will be leading several assemblies to the whole school with the help of the JTAs. These assemblies will focus on the messages of 'Be Bright Be Seen' as we move into darker nights and also helmet safety. Please look out for a separate letter with dates and information of the events that the children can get involved with and support.

After School Clubs

During the school holidays we have had a security door fitted in our entrance which provides us with additional security and a lobby area. In line with safeguarding procedures the door is locked throughout the day with a buzzer entry system. As Breakfast Club and after school clubs are an extension of our school day, we will be using the door system in this way from 8am - 5pm. We have also had a higher fence erected before entry to the school playground which is locked during the school day and locked again straight after school pick up. Therefore we know the children taking part in after school clubs that are outside are safe on the playground. Prior to the start of Mark Barber's Football Club, we have noticed several parents/carers in the hall helping their child to get changed for the session. As a school we need to ensure we are in line with safeguarding policy and we are therefore asking parents/carers not to come into the hall at this point in the day. The school staff will support the younger children to get changed and ready for the session. We are also kindly asking that parents/carers wait outside the school entrance rather than in the school Reception area/playground until after school clubs finish. We will then bring the children attending all clubs, outdoor and indoor, to the lobby area and ensure they are collected by their parent/carer. Thank you in anticipation of your support with these arrangements. Changes and arrangements are made in the best interests of all children.
