In your opinion what does the school do well?

- Breakfast Club
- Very caring and supportive school - school providing support to both the child and parents
- A whole school/team approach – all children feeling part of a team
- Lovely friendly atmosphere, safe environment and approachable staff
- Different clubs, lots of extra-curricular activity is available, school trips and awards
- Values the whole child not just academic success by encouraging children to develop in all areas, emotionally, physically, socially and academically
- Communication

Several responses were linked to:

- School providing a regular after school club
- Home based tasks to involve parents more in learning
- I would like to see school encourage practical skills

We have not included **all** of the responses, whether they were positive comments or areas for improvement. All feedback has been shared with staff in school and the relevant staff members and the staff team will be working on addressing any areas that have been brought to our attention.

Homework

In response to the question relating to homework, views and opinions can vary. We feel the changes we made at the start of the academic year have improved the balance of subjects the children receive for homework. Our main focus is on the key skills of spelling, reading and time tables. Homework is an area that is subjective and parents/carers have differing views. After School Hours Club

In response to how we could develop further as a school the majority of feedback was related to providing an after school hours club. The letter/survey sent from the Parish Plan re-write team through school explained our position in terms of being able to offer a regular After School Club. In addition to this the results of the Parish Plan re-write team's survey indicated a demand for an after school hours club. In the letter sent this week by the team it clearly communicates the developments and next steps in this area. We will continue to update you on further developments and we recommend you also look out for further detail on social media and in The Village Bulletin.
