

At Hutton Cranswick CP School, we aim to create a holistic and broad learning experience for all of our children. We recognise the role that our families play in this and the learning opportunities that take place outside of the regular school day. We also value the role parents/carers play through their support of home learning.

As a school, we ask that you regularly read with your child. This will enable your child to practice the skills they are developing at school and also discuss the books they bring home. As the children become more independent readers, we ask that you continue to engage in as many ways as you are able to with their reading.

We also ask that you try and find regular time to help your child learn their spelling lists, number bonds and the times tables. If your child is confident with the tables up to 12×12 as they move through school, it really does make many other mathematical concepts much easier to grasp and master.

At Hutton Cranswick CP School, we believe that home learning should be enjoyable and manageable for all concerned and we endeavour to focus on learning that will add genuine value to what your child is learning in school. Supporting your child with home learning will result in preparing the children as much as possible for their class learning and further their confidence in these areas.

Below is an overview of home learning in each year group.

Year Group	Home Learning
<b>Reception</b>	Reading books sent home and changed weekly. Tricky words stuck in the front of the Reading Journals to learn over the year. Maths number cards to learn and read in and out of order.
<b>All classes from Y1-Y6</b>	All children will be given a <b>login</b> for <b>Spelling Shed, Mathletics, Times Table Rockstars</b> and <b>Purple Mash</b> . For Y1 these will be stuck in their Reading Record, Y2 will be in their Spelling Book and for KS2 these will be in stuck in their Homework book. Please encourage your children to go on these sites to ensure regular practice of key skills. The children may have additional learning tasks linked to their HCCPS Learning Challenge sent home at points throughout the year.
<b>Year 1</b>	Reading books sent home and changed weekly. Spellings sent home to learn. Occasionally Mathletics tasks will be set.
<b>Year 2</b>	Reading books sent home and changed weekly. Weekly spellings sent home to learn for the weekly test. Occasionally Mathletics tasks will be set.
<b>Year 3 and Year 4</b>	Weekly spellings sent home to learn for the weekly test. Reading books sent home are ongoing and once completed are recorded by the children/parents in their homework book. Occasionally Reading Circles and Mathletics tasks will be set to support learning in school.
<b>Year 5 and Year 6</b>	Spellings sent home to learn for the test. Reading books/extracts sent home are ongoing and once completed they are recorded by the children. There is a Guided Reading Record Sheet for them to record this information, in the back of their Guided Reading exercise book. Staff in school will monitor this record to ensure the children are reading regularly at home. Reading Circles set <b>fortnightly</b> to support learning in school. Relevant Maths task set from Mathletics <b>fortnightly</b> to support learning in school.  <b><i>Year 6 only – Children will also be sent grammar activities. From January the children will receive Revision Guides and most of their learning tasks will be set from these alongside weekly practice of spellings, times tables and reading.</i></b>
