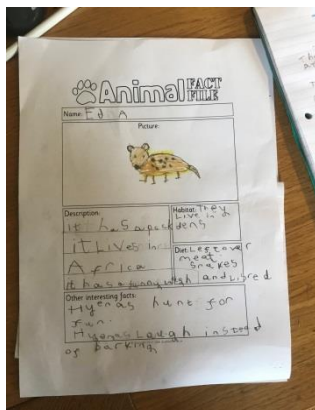

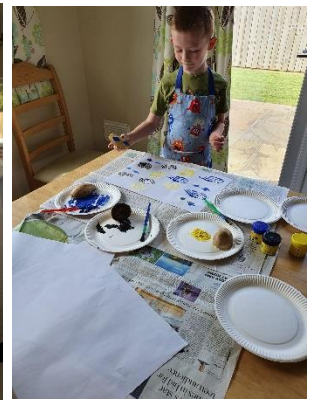
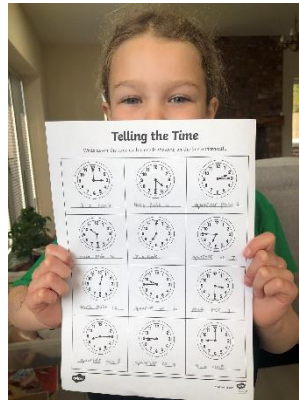
We would like to say another huge well done to you all for all of your hard work. It is very different learning from home but you are all doing an amazing job and continue to make us proud.
