Now that we are in national lockdown, we will communicate home learning through GoogleClassroom. Your child has a GoogleClassroom account and they are familiar with it as we have used it in school. They will need to set up Google Classroom on their device - this can be a laptop, chromebook, ipad/ tablet or phone. Please follow the steps set out in your child's homework diary or follow the steps at the end of this letter. If your child has absolutely no access to a device of any sort please email us as soon as possible. For the children who do not have access to a device, a hard copy of this week's learning will be made available and can be collected from the school office from 8.30am Wednesday 6th January.



The children will be set four main learning tasks per day in Google Classroom (English and Maths plus two other activities) and will also have some optional/ extension tasks to complete. The children will be able to submit their work through Google Classroom for the teacher to give feedback. You will be able to reach your child's teacher via email 8.45am - 3:30pm. To get started on Google Classroom:

- 1) Open Google Chrome on your device.
- 2) Type 'Google Classroom' into the search bar.
- 3) Click the Google Classroom link.
- 4) Go to sign in 'Google Classroom'
- 5) If you already have Google accounts set up you will need to select 'add another account'.
- 6) Enter your child's email and password for Google Classroom (found in their homework diary).
- 7) This should open your child's account.

You will see two groups in the Google Classroom area. Year 3 need to access the 'Year 3 Remote Learning' for their home learning and Year 4 need to access 'Year 4 Home Learning'. If you cannot see these icons please contact us and we will hopefully be able to guide you through it.
