Dear Parents and Carers

**I am writing to inform you that your child needs to self-isolate on a precautionary basis.**

In line with government direction, your child and other pupils in **Year 1 and 2** have been identified as close contacts of a suspected case of COVID-19 and will now need to self-isolate as a **precaution** with immediate effect until midnight on **Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> July**. This is a period of 10 days from when they last had contact with the person affected, in line with government guidance.

**If a negative PCR test result is received**, we will let you know and your child will be able to return to school the following school day. If you do not hear from us, you can assume the self-isolation must continue and we will then look forward to welcoming your child back into school on **Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> July**.

If your child in Year 1 and 2 has any brothers or sisters in another year group at our school or any other school/college, they can still go to school unless they or someone in your household develops symptoms.

Self-isolation means your child:

- must not leave your home.
- may not go to school, go out and meet friends or go to public places.
- cannot go on public transport or use taxis.
- cannot go to the shops.
- cannot have family, friends or any visitors round to your home.
- can get exercise at home or in your garden but cannot meet with neighbours over the fence.

Should your child start to get symptoms of COVID-19 or return a positive result from a rapid, asymptomatic test (LFD Test) please self-isolate, arrange a confirmatory PCR test within two days, please arrange to get them tested.

The main symptoms of COVID-19 include:

- **a high temperature** – this means they may feel hot to touch on their chest or back (you do not need to take their temperature with a thermometer)
- **a new, continuous cough** – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if they usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- **a loss or change to their sense of smell or taste** – this means they may tell you that they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different.
