Dear Parents and Carers

I am writing to inform you that we have received confirmation that two members of our Year 5 and 6 bubble have received a **positive PCR test result for COVID-19**. Following government and local authority guidance the individual concerned and their family has already started household isolation.

In line with government direction, your child and other pupils in Year 5 and 6 have been identified as close contacts and will now need to self-isolate with immediate effect until midnight on Thursday 22nd July. This is a period of 10 days from when they last had contact with the person affected, in line with government guidance.

We look forward to welcoming your child back into school on **Friday 23rd July**. If your child in Year 5 or Year 6 has any brothers or sisters in another year group at our school or any other school/college, they can still go to school unless they or someone in your household develops symptoms.

Self-isolation means your child:

- must not leave your home.
- may not go to school, go out and meet friends or go to public places.
- cannot go on public transport or use taxis.
- cannot go to the shops.
- cannot have family, friends or any visitors round to your home.
- can get exercise at home or in your garden but cannot meet with neighbours over the fence.

Should your child start to get symptoms of COVID-19 or returns a positive result from a rapid asymptomatic test (LFD Test) please arrange a confirmatory PCR test within two days and inform the school immediately.

The main symptoms of COVID-19 include:

- **a high temperature** – this means they may feel hot to touch on their chest or back (you do not need to take their temperature with a thermometer)
- **a new, continuous cough** – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if they usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- **a loss or change to their sense of smell or taste** – this means they may tell you that they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different.
