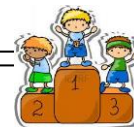


Sports Day

Consequently, to enable us to authorise your child/children's absence you need to provide us with evidence of your advance ticket purchase. Please send a copy of your booking confirmation to the school office on jscholes@huttoncranswick.eriding.net - if we do not receive this and you still take your child out of school then this will go down as an unauthorised absence.

If you do not intend on taking your child to the show school will remain open as normal on both days.
